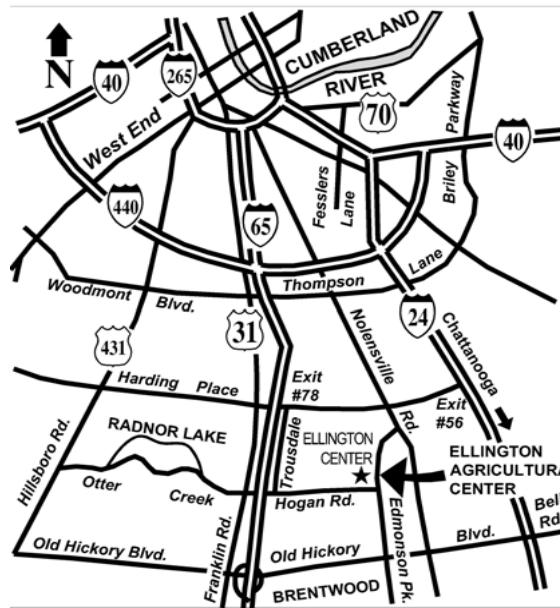

Directions to Ellington Agricultural Center:

From I-65:

- Take Exit #78-A East on Harding Place.
- Take a right onto Nolenville Rd.
- Take a right onto Edmonson Pike and another right at the entrance to the Ellington Agricultural Center (White Fencing).
- Go through the 3-Way Stop.
- TWRA is on the right.

From I-24:

- Take Exit #56 West on Harding Place to the Nolenville Road intersection.
- Turn left onto Nolenville Road and travel south 1/10 mile and turn right onto Edmonson Pike.
- Travel 1 ½ miles on Edmonson Pike.
- The west entrance to Ellington Agricultural Center is on the right.
